Introduction

The AMAQ Foundation has been established to raise funds to provide improved medical services to people in need, particularly in remote and rural Queensland and to contribute to medical education and research.

The Scholarship

The AMAQ Foundation wishes to make available one scholarship per year for students attending James Cook University Medical School. The scholarship will be in the form of an annual non-repayable grant of \$5,000.

Basic Criteria

To be eligible for consideration for a Foundation scholarship students must meet the following basic criteria:

- Have commenced first year of the Medical Course at James Cook University (JCU) and successfully completed the first semester
- Demonstrate a degree of financial hardship
- Not be the recipient of any other significant scholarship, for example, the Commonwealth Government Rural Australia Medical Undergraduate Scholarship or *The Australian Medical Scholarship*
- Has expressed an interest in practicing medicine within indigenous or rural communities in Queensland.
